WHY DO WE NEED THE CAPCROSSPLAN PROJECT?

In the Slovenian-Hungarian border region, there is a need to develop an institutional network that can be involved in the preparation of strategic documents and program planning, be it local, regional or national concepts and strategies.

The aim of the project is to establish a cross-border regional development network that identifies the potentials of the region and prepares initiatives and proposals for the development strategies.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN OUTCOMES AND OUTPUTS OF THE PROJECT?

One of the most important results of the project will be a signed protocol on the cooperation between project partners and stakeholders of the cross-border network of development organizations. Protocol will contain rules, agreements and procedures for future cooperation in the field of strategic planning.

Other important results of the project are trainings and mutual learning of stakeholders on the topic "EU in the programming period 2021 – 2027". The project will also result in a cross-border online platform, where news related to the project and current information on strategic planning will be available.



STAKEHOLDER GROUPS

During the implementation of the capCROSSplan project, key stakeholder groups are set up both on the Slovenian (Pomurje and Podravje regions) and the Hungarian side (Vas and Zala counties).

Territorial actors relevant to strategic planning and programming, such as municipalities, regional development agencies, rural development associations, national parks, educational and vocational training institutions and non-governmental organizations are invited to participate as members of the groups.

In each region, at least 5 key stakeholder groups have been identified. During the project, they actively contribute to the implementation of the project activities.

40 other organizations will join to the project, and they will sign a letter of intent to support the work of the network in future planning and strategy development.

COMPETENCES FOR STRATEGIC PLANNING

We will increase the preparedness of the involved organizations for strategic planning through trainings and workshops during the project. In addition to the trainings on developing soft skills, the organizations can also take part in trainings on the objectives of the European Union:

- A more intelligent Europe
- A greener, carbon-free Europe
- A more connected Europe
- A more social Europe
- A Europe closer to citizens
